• Item I: Discussion ensued with Consultants outlining the planned RFP process: Advertise week of October 6; must be out a minimum of 3 weeks; review submittals week of Oct. 27, rate proposals week of November 17, submit ratings to LTBID Advisory Committee; week of

- December 1, Advisory Committee submits recommendation to LTBA Board of Directors for contract approval.
- Item II: coordinate efforts with other community groups, such as Little Tokyo Public Safety Association and Little Tokyo Sparkle.
- Item III: incident reporting/posting; training; process for filing grievances; nothing more critical than safety
- Item IV: transparency; general framework; did not receive notice (RFP consultant response: check with County Assessor Office – per State law, notification by US Mail with county address on file)

## VI. Advisory Committee Nominations

- Nomination notices were sent out three times to 175 email addresses, also posted, and sent to condo and apartment building property managers for distribution to owners/tenants.
- Following a discussion, nomination deadline was extended to Friday, Sept. 12. Nominations should be sent to <a href="mailto:board@VisitLittleTokyo.org">board@VisitLittleTokyo.org</a>. To quality, candidates must be property owners, have made some indication that they support the BID concept (by turning in their signed petitions and/or voting "YES" by the July 1 City Council hearing date.
- LTBA manages the BID; LTBID Advisory Committee represents the LTBID; Steering Committee
  is predecessor to the Advisory Committee, which represents a cross section of the community
  (business, legacy business, residents)
- LTBID Advisory Committee members must adhere to City of Los Angeles BID Policies and Guidelines. City Clerk's Office representative is present if you have any questions.
